Tips / Reminders

When presenting – breathe, speak slower than you normally would, make some eye contact with audience, and “appear” confident (even if you’re not).

Be courteous and attentive when others are presenting. Look for “good things” and possible suggestions for improvement next time.

Take good notes (and sketch) while listening to other presentations. Use a combination of complete sentences and “bullet-point” lists.
